I.

The name of the corporation is Friends of King, a Nonprofit Corporation.

- A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and public purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to carry out the planning, funding, and/or operation of supplemental educational programs to enrich the curriculum of basic education offered to the students at Thomas Starr King Middle School, and to conduct fundraising activities for the support of such programs


